(License # 12788) with Limited Mental Health component had deficiencies identified at the time of the survey: 0081 - Training - Staff In-Service - 58A-5.0191(2) FAC Based on record review and interview the facility failed to ensure that staff who provide direct care to residents, other than nurses, certified nursing assistants, or home health aides receive a minimum of 1 hour in-service training in control, including universal precautions, and facility sanitation procedures before providing personal care to residents for 1 out of 5 sampled staff (Staff B). Findings included: Review of Staff B's personnel record revealed she was hired on . . . The facility did not have documentation of control training available for review. On at 12:20 PM the Administrator stated on the phone that she did not know that she was missing the training and that she will make an appointment for her to have the training. Based on record review and interview the facility failed to ensure that staff who had a break in service of more than 90 days from a position that required screening by a specified agency had a level II background screening completed previously to being employed for 1 out of 5 sampled staff (Staff C).

Findings included:

Review of the personnel record of Staff C revealed that she was hired on . The level II background screening was dated . The only employment history on her application was from 2015 to 2015.

On at 12:30 PM Staff C stated that she worked for about 7 months in a private house taking care of an elderly previously to working at Oasis and that she was not required a background screening to work there. The Administrator stated at 12:35 PM on the phone that her background was good for 5 years.
