Findings include: A medication assistance observation was conducted on _____ at 9:15 AM. Resident #3 was seated in the wellness _____. _____ informed the nurse that he needed his medications. The nurse poured the medications for the resident including _____ 10meq, one pill. The nurse handed the card to the surveyor which revealed an order for _____ 10meq take 2 pills. The nurse then administered a dose of _____ eye drops. The resident spoke up stating that he needed his second eye medication. The nurse insisted that he only got one eye drop medication at that time. The resident continued to insist and the surveyor and nurse then checked the physician orders for Resident # 3, which revealed that he was to receive a dose of Briminodine eye drops at this time. The nurse confirmed that she would not have administered the Brimondine eye drops without the surveyors encouragement to check the physician orders. The Surveyor then asked the nurse to read the physician's order and the _____ card with the _____. The nurse read the order and exclaimed, "oh no !" I should have given him two. The nurse confirmed that she failed to administer the correct dose of _____ until pointed out by this surveyor. Class III
