The Department completed a full inspection of your Assisted Living Facility on 02/27/2025 and found that your facility does not meet the Assisted Living Facility requirements.

Consultation:

WAC 388-112A-0710 What is CPR/first-aid training? CPR/first-aid training is training that meets the guidelines established by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). Under OSHA guidelines, training must include hands on skills development through the use of mannequins or trainee partners.

WAC 388-78A-2474 Training and home care aide certification requirements.

(2) The assisted living facility must ensure all assisted living facility administrators, or their designees, and caregivers hired on or after January 7, 2012 meet the long-term care worker training requirements of chapter 388-112A WAC, including but not limited

to:

(d) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation and first aid; and

One of four medication technicians failed to possess a valid Cardiopulmonary/ First-Aid (CPR/FA) card. The CPR/FA card provided, showed it had been issued by an on-line (computer based) company. The Assisted Living Facility (ALF) enrolled the medication technician in an approved CPR/FA course. This deficiency was corrected on-site at the time of the visit.

You Must:

- Begin the process of correcting the deficiency or deficiencies immediately; and
- Complete correction as soon as possible.

You Are Not:

- Required to submit a plan-of-correction for the deficiency or deficiencies found.

The Department May:

- Inspect the facility to determine if you have corrected all deficiencies.

You May:

- Contact me for clarification of the deficiency or deficiencies found.

In Addition, You May:

- Request an **Informal Dispute Resolution (IDR)** review within 10 working days after you receive this letter. Your IDR request **must** include:
 - o What specific deficiency or deficiencies you disagree with;
 - o Why you disagree with each deficiency; and
 - o Whether you want an IDR to occur in-person, by telephone or as a paper review.
