Unfortunately after contacting the ACF, they were unable to obtain a transcript for the Dining Services Manager. Ron our Dining Services Manager did not have a copy of his coursework either. The ACF does recognize the Dining Services Managers certificate. With 30 hours of additional course work our Dining Services Manager will be a "Certified Culinarian". The Dining Services Manager has enrolled in a Chef Nutrition course. The administrator will send updates to the State of Wyoming documenting the Dining Services Manager progress in the Chef Nutrition course. Enrollment was completed on 8/29/18. 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(S5074)	Continued From page 1 physical demands and Nutrition and Medical Nutrition Therapy. Review of the manager's resume showed more than 40 years of experience in restaurant management and operations. However, there was no information related to experience or education with nutrition and medical nutrition therapy. Review of certificates showed the manager had a certificate for the ServeSafe Food Protection Manager examination which was good through 4/2021. In addition, the manager had a certificate from the American Culinary Federation (ACF) dated June 1, 1990. Information related to nutrition and medical nutrition therapy was lacking. Interview with the administrator on 8/27/18 at 1:50 PM revealed they had been attempting to get the transcripts that resulted in the original ACF certificate. However, the Federation was unable to obtain them. The ACF provided information to the administrator and manager that they would honor the original certificate and if the manager were to take 30 hours of additional course work they would certify him with the current certificate for a "Certified Culinarian." This course work covered the lacking nutritional education. Review of the enrollment agreement showed the manager was enrolled in a "Chef Nutrition" course with a start date of 8/29/18 and an end date of 3/1/2019.	(S5074)
