This standard is not met as evidenced by: Based on review of employee files and staff interview, the facility failed to assure tuberculin testing was done prior to resident contact for 2 of 5 employees reviewed. The findings were: Review of personnel files revealed the following concerns: a. Employee #1 was hired on 5/12/08. The tuberculin documentation showed testing was done on 5/8/08, but the results were not documented. b. Employee #2 was hired on 6/16/08. Tuberculin testing was done on 6/12/08, but no results were recorded. On 7/17/08 at 9:50 AM, the payroll/business office employee, who retrieved the personnel files, stated there was no other tuberculin documentation. She further stated both employees still worked at the facility.	S 000	S000 The facility will ensure that tuberculin testing is accomplished for each employee upon employment and before resident contract begins and annually thereafter. This will be accomplished by: A) Employee #1 and #2 will be receive a TB test and it will be read within the required timeframe. B) An audit of TB testing compliance will be made of all employees. All newly hired employees will be receive a TB test with results read within the required time frame and before resident contract. C) A new infection control nurse has been hired and will track TB testing on hire and annually. D) A quality improvement monitoring tool will be developed to track compliance with TB testing on hire and annually. The results of the TB monitoring will be reported quarterly to the facility's performance improvement committee by the infection control nurse	8/22/08
